

**CHARGES AGAINST
POLICE OFFICER LUIGI SARLI**

Police Officer Luigi Sarli, Star Number 14398, is charged with violating the following rules contained in Article V of the Rules and Regulations of the Chicago Police Department, which were in full force and effect on the date of the alleged violations:

- Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.
- Rule 3: Any failure to promote the Department's efforts to implement its policy or accomplish its goals.
- Rule 6: Disobedience of an order or directive, whether written or oral.
- Rule 38: Unlawful or unnecessary use or display of a weapon.

SPECIFICATIONS

1. On or about October 4, 2018, at or near the alleyway of 3015 West Argyle Street, Chicago, IL, Officer Sarli, while sitting in the rear seat of an unmarked police SUV, improperly discharged his firearm at or into a moving 2015 Jeep Grand Cherokee. Officer Sarli thereby:
 - a. Engaged in action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department in violation of Rule 2;
 - b. Failed to promote the Department's efforts to implement its policy or accomplish its goals in violation of Rule 3;
 - c. Disobeyed General Order G03-02 in violation of Rule 6, disobedience of an order or directive, whether written or oral; and
 - d. Unlawfully or unnecessarily used or displayed a weapon in violation of Rule 38.

Based on the foregoing charges and specifications, the Superintendent recommends that Police Officer Luigi Sarli, Star No. 14398, be discharged from the Chicago Police Department.
