Charges Filed with the Police Board

The following charges have been filed with the Police Board by the Superintendent of Police. The public is reminded that the filing of charges is not evidence of guilt. The accused officer is presumed innocent and is entitled to a fair hearing at which the Superintendent has the burden of proving guilt by a preponderance of the evidence.

CHARGES AGAINST POLICE OFFICER ELMER CARRILLO, JR.

Officer Elmer Carrillo, Jr., Star No. 8392, is charged with violating the following Rules contained in Article V of the Rules and Regulations of the Chicago Police Department, which were in full force and effect on the date of the alleged violations:

- Rule 2: Any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department.
- Rule 6: Disobedience of an order or directive, whether written or oral.

SPECIFICATIONS

- 1. On or about November 14, 2023, at or near 3510 South Michigan Avenue, Chicago, Illinois, Police Officer Elmer Carrillo, Jr. provided a urine specimen that contained marijuana metabolites and/or on or about some time prior to November 14, 2023, Officer Carrillo used some amount of marijuana and/or cannabis, thereby violating:
 - a. Rule 2, any action or conduct which impedes the Department's efforts to achieve its policy and goals or brings discredit upon the Department; and/or
 - b. Rule 6, disobeying an order or directive, whether written or oral, to wit: Employee Resource E01-09, "Drugs, Drug Abuse, and Mandatory Physical and/or Psychological Examinations."

Based on the foregoing charges and specifications, the Superintendent recommends that Officer Elmer Carrillo, Jr. Star Number 8392, be discharged from the Chicago Police Department.
