The remarks made by the remaining speakers did not require a response in addition to that provided at the meeting.

# Chicago Police Department's Response to Community Input at the 20 October 2022 Police Board Meeting

- Regarding concerns brought forth by Ms. Chatman-Regis, Captain Deane of the 006<sup>th</sup> District contact Ms. Chatman-Regis and discussed with her the use of District Coordination Officers to assist in addressing her concerns. Captain Deane also related that he will be utilizing 006<sup>th</sup> District Abandoned Building Community Policing Officers for follow-up about identified locations. He also related that he will utilize 006<sup>th</sup> District Tactical Teams regarding drug sales in the area of concern and make a request to the Narcotics Unit for additional assistance.
- Regarding issues brought forth by Mrs. Hendrix, the Bureau of Detectives related that the assigned detective met with the Hendrix family on 12 October 21 and related medical examiner's findings to the family on 29 October 21.

On 02 November 2021, disciplinary actions were taken against the detective for failure to notify next of kin in a timely fashion.
