REPORT OF COMMUNITY INPUT RECEIVED AT THE PUBLIC MEETING ON OCTOBER 21, 2021

The Office of the Police Board determined that the remarks made by the other speakers did not require a response in addition to that provided at the meeting.

Chicago Police Department's Response to Community Input at the 21 October 2021 Police Board Meeting

The 006th District commander expended the following efforts in response to various speakers' remarks:

- Speakers informed the 006th District commander of a prostitution ring operating in the 400 East Block of 80th Street. The commander communicated that an arrest had been made and other individuals had moved from the location.
- Speakers expressed concern about crime and disorder issues at the store located at 457 E. 79th Street. The commander communicated that Business Affairs and Consumer Protection personnel have visited the location in recent months and observed no violations. Nevertheless, the commander committed to having the District Coordination Officer (DCO) contact residents and address their concerns.
