1 VICE PRESIDENT FOREMAN: Okay. We're going to  
2 get started. Good evening. I'm Ghian Foreman,  
3 Vice President of the Chicago Police Department  
4 Board, and I'm calling the meeting to order.

5 President Lightfoot and Reverend Eaddy  
6 are unable to attend the meeting in-person and wish  
7 to attend via audio conference. Is a motion to  
8 permit them to do so?

9 MS. FRY: So moved.

10 MS. DELGADO: Second.

11 VICE PRESIDENT FOREMAN: All favor?

12 (Ayes in unison.)

13 VICE PRESIDENT FOREMAN: None opposed. The  
14 motion passes.

15 The first item of business is the  
16 approval of the minutes of the Board's regular  
17 meeting held on March 16, 2017.

18 Is there a motion to approve the minutes?

19 MS. FRY: So moved.

20 MS. DELGADO: Second.

21 VICE PRESIDENT FOREMAN: All in favor?

22 (Ayes in unison.)

23 VICE PRESIDENT FOREMAN: The motion passes.

24 Our next regular public meeting will be



1 held on Thursday, May 18, at 7:30, here at Chicago  
2 Public Safety Headquarters.

3 At this time I'd ask for a motion to  
4 close a series of executive sessions for the  
5 purposes of considering personnel matters and  
6 litigation as authorized by Section  
7 2(c)(1),(3),(4), and (11) of the Illinois Open  
8 Meetings Act

9 Is there such a motion?

10 MS. FRY: So moved.

11 MS. DELGADO: Second.

12 VICE PRESIDENT FOREMAN: All in favor?

13 (Ayes in unison.)

14 VICE PRESIDENT FOREMAN: None opposed. The  
15 motion passes.

16 A report of disciplinary action taken by  
17 the Board during the previous month has been made  
18 available at this evening's meeting. This report  
19 and the Board's written findings and decisions are  
20 posted on the Board's web site.

21 The Police Board, as authorized by the  
22 Open Meetings Act, has considered in closed meeting  
23 several disciplinary cases. The Board will now  
24 take final actions on these cases.



1           Regarding case No. 14 PB 2874, on May,  
2 2015, the Police Board finds Police Officer Eugene  
3 Posey not guilty of all charges pertaining to an  
4 off-duty altercation. The Superintendent appealed  
5 this decision. The Circuit Court reversed the not  
6 guilty finding and remanded the case to the Board,  
7 ordering the Board to decide the appropriate  
8 discipline to Officer Posey based on the evidence  
9 presented in the record.

10           After re-considering this matter in  
11 response to the Court's order, is there an motion  
12 to order a sixty-day suspension as penalty as  
13 recommended by the Superintendent?

14           MS. FRY: So moved.

15           MS. DELGADO: Second.

16           VICE PRESIDENT FOREMAN: All in favor by  
17 raising of hands? None opposed. Voting in favor  
18 are Board members Lightfoot, Delgado, Eaddy,  
19 Flores, Fry, O'Malley, Simpson, Sweeney, and myself.  
20 The motion passes by unanimous vote.

21           Is there a motion to adopt a writing  
22 finding and decision that have been reviewed by all  
23 Board members who participated in the case?

24           MS. FRY: So moved.



1 MR. O'MALLEY: Second.

2 VICE PRESIDENT FOREMAN: All in favor?

3 (Ayes in unison.)

4 VICE PRESIDENT FOREMAN: None opposed. The  
5 motion passes.

6 Regarding case No. 16 PB 2904, the  
7 Superintendent filed charges to discharge Sergeant  
8 James Pader from the Chicago Police Department for  
9 recording an absent officer present for duty. The  
10 Superintendent subsequently moved to withdraw the  
11 charges because discipline was ordered and accepted  
12 prior to the filing of the charges.

13 Is there a motion to grant the  
14 Superintendent's motion to withdraw the charges?

15 MS. FRY: So moved.

16 MR. O'MALLEY: Second.

17 VICE PRESIDENT FOREMAN: All in favor by a show  
18 of hands. None opposed.

19 Voting in favor are Board members  
20 Lightfoot, Delgado, Eaddy, Flores, Fry, O'Malley,  
21 Simpson, Sweeney, and myself. The motion passes by  
22 unanimous vote.

23 Regarding case No. 16 PB 2917, the  
24 Superintendent filed charges to discharge Police



1 officer Carl Belaschky from the Chicago Police  
2 Department for making false reports regarding  
3 doctor's appointments. The Superintendent  
4 subsequently moved to withdraw the charges without  
5 prejudice because the Respondent is on inactive  
6 status and has not been served with the charges.

7 Is there a motion to grant the  
8 Superintendent's motion to withdraw the charges?

9 MS. FRY: So moved.

10 MR. O'MALLEY: Second.

11 VICE PRESIDENT FOREMAN: All in favor by a show  
12 of hands. Any opposed?

13 Voting in favor are Board members  
14 Lightfoot, Delgado, Eaddy, Flores, Fry, O'Malley,  
15 Simpson, Sweeney, and myself. The motion passes by  
16 a unanimous vote.

17 The Board's decision in the cases on  
18 which we took final action this evening will be  
19 entered as of today's date, and will be issued to  
20 the parties. A copy of the written decisions will  
21 be posted on the Board's web site within ten  
22 business days as required by the Municipal Code of  
23 Chicago.

24 The general orders and other directives



1 issued by the Superintendent of Police during  
2 previous month are listed in the books made  
3 available at this evening's meeting, and are posted  
4 on the Police Department's web site.

5 The next item is the Superintendent's  
6 report to the Board.

7 CHIEF WALLER: I apologize for the  
8 Superintendent not being able to attend tonight,  
9 and I welcome you all.

10 In the spirit of honest and open  
11 dialog -- forgive me. I'm Chief of Patrol Fred  
12 Waller, for those of you who don't me. As I said,  
13 in the spirit of open dialog, honest dialog, and  
14 open forum where your voices can be heard, I  
15 encourage you all to continue to participate in  
16 forums such as this, but also to participate in the  
17 table top discussions that we have. We had one  
18 this past Tuesday at Westinghouse, and we will have  
19 one this Tuesday coming up on the 25th at Sullivan  
20 High School.

21 It's not this type of forum, but it's  
22 where we sit down at tables and we have some open  
23 discussion and open dialog with each other to have  
24 suggestions for what we want CAPS to look like



1 going forward.

2 So I thank you all for coming and I  
3 encourage you to come to that forum. Thank you.

4 VICE PRESIDENT FOREMAN: Thank you. I will now  
5 call upon those members of the public who signed up  
6 in advance to speak. When your name is called,  
7 please step up to the microphone. We ask that you  
8 limit your comments to two minutes.

9 The first speaker is Gregg Greer.

10 MR. GREER: Good morning, everyone. Good  
11 afternoon, evening, I guess it's still evening.

12 A week ago there was a gentleman by the  
13 name of Shawn Brider, and I am here because the  
14 case of Mr. Brider is a myth to the public. We  
15 need information on the death of Shawn Brider.

16 I'm a representative, I'm the president  
17 of the Southern Christian Leadership Conference of  
18 Chicago. And I tell you what, Chicago police, you  
19 asked about CAPS, Mr. Fred, you asked about CAPS.  
20 I'm going to tell you, if you want to spend a lot  
21 of money on CAPS, start working on public trust.  
22 Because we don't trust the police. There is a high  
23 level of mistrust. We need to turn that around.  
24 And the first thing that you can do is when we have



1 high profile case like Shawn Brider, find a better  
2 way to communicate that to the public.

3 To date there hasn't been anything said  
4 to the public about the death of this gentleman,  
5 his family, it's immense. They don't know what  
6 happened. They have to deal with burial and  
7 bereavement. No information. It's a public  
8 disservice. We need to change that.

9 And I'm also asking for, in the death of  
10 Kujoun Raye, that John D. Poulos, a sergeant who  
11 was promoted in 2015, with a lengthy file,  
12 questionable file, multiple disciplinaries,  
13 including a murder in 2013, was promoted. He needs  
14 to be terminated. He is on City payroll as we  
15 speak.

16 John D. Poulos owns a bar on the north  
17 side of Chicago in Lincoln Park, which is against  
18 protocols for Chicago. Correct me if I am wrong,  
19 it's against your protocols. That investigation  
20 started in 2013. Guess what? That's still open.

21 we need the investigations closed. We  
22 need police officers who act outside of public  
23 interest, we need them terminated. This has to  
24 end. If you want to get public trust back, this is



1 what you got to do.

2 And last thing, we know that the consent  
3 decree from the DOJ is pretty much in the air under  
4 Judge Sessions. But we would ask, again, for  
5 public trust to happen, we would ask for Chicago  
6 police, the brass, to consider abiding by that  
7 consent decree now. All right? Thank you.

8 VICE PRESIDENT FOREMAN: The next speaker is  
9 Joseph Pughsley.

10 MR. PUGHSLEY: My name is Joseph Pughsley, and  
11 before I get to my comments, I want to say that I  
12 look at this Board and it's a distaste and a  
13 disgrace that I ever seen in my life. This is a  
14 disgrace. You all should be ashamed of yourself,  
15 every single last one of you.

16 with that being said, I want to talk  
17 about John Poulos. That's the first one I want to  
18 talk about. why is John Poulos has not been  
19 convicted? why did he shoot that boy behind his  
20 back? I'm talking about Kujoun Raye. And he was  
21 promoted as sergeant? why? we need answers, and  
22 we're not going to tolerate this no more. That's  
23 the first question.

24 Number two, I don't know why ain't



1 Johnson here, but I want you to relay this message.  
2 why do we not have no report of Shawn Brider?  
3 First of all, why was he pulled over to begin with?  
4 Just because he was sleeping in his car with a  
5 daughter? why was he being bothered with? See,  
6 this Police Department has a history of pulling  
7 people over for no apparent reason and it has to  
8 stop.

9 So what are you going to do about it?  
10 what are you going to do about it? You all about  
11 to be -- see, Mr. John Poulos (inaudible). This is  
12 unacceptable to the highest degree.

13 So what are you going to do? Is John  
14 Poulos going to be terminated? And is you all  
15 going to give what we want in Shawn Brider's  
16 report? That's all we want. We don't want nothing  
17 more, we don't want nothing less. We want the  
18 public to know that you are protecting us, and we  
19 are not getting the protection.

20 We want the justice that we deserve.  
21 These cops should not be out on the streets. They  
22 should be terminated to the highest degree. So,  
23 what, you all looking crazy. You all look like I  
24 don't know what I'm talking about. You better do



1 your job or we going to do our job. We going to  
2 continue to protest. We going to continue to shut  
3 down stores. We going to do all these things until  
4 you do your job.

5 If we don't get it, shut it down.

6 (Chanting by audience.)

7 VICE PRESIDENT FOREMAN: Eric Russell.

8 MR. RUSSELL: My name is Eric Russell, I'm the  
9 president of the Tree of Life Justice League of  
10 Illinois. I'm a spokesman for the Baby Jones  
11 family, Jose Nueves'(phonetic) family, and just a  
12 host of other families that have been murder,  
13 tortured, and brutalized by the Chicago police.

14 Earlier this week I had the misfortune of  
15 attending an event for -- I had to attend the event  
16 for the Unwanted Sisterhood. When I first received  
17 the invitation from the Unwanted Sisterhood, I  
18 thought maybe it was something that was affiliated  
19 with me, by me being a fraternity. I'm a member of  
20 Kappa Alpha Psi.

21 But when I arrived, the Unwanted  
22 Sisterhood is 30 black, Hispanic, and Latino women  
23 whose children have been murdered by police. And I  
24 secreted my sincerity as a member of my fraternity.



1 But these women was forced into this bond by  
2 murderous police.

3 what I'd like to say is that this week I  
4 had the displeasure to witness the deposition of  
5 officer Rialmo. And we watched as this Chicago  
6 police officer had this grin on his face like he  
7 was the cat that swallowed the canary. This racist  
8 killer cop should have been indicted for murder.  
9 Now the blood of Baby Jones is now on your hands.

10 Because we are outraged as a community,  
11 because, but for the grace of God, Bettie Jones  
12 could have been any of our mothers. When we as  
13 activists say indict, convict, send those killer  
14 cops to jail, the whole damn system is guilty as  
15 hell. I swore an oath to the children of Bettie  
16 Jones that I would speak their words, that I would  
17 advocate on their behalf, to my great get up in the  
18 morning day, or there was justice for Bettie Jones.

19 Bettie Jones did not deserve to die. You  
20 had a mountain of evidence. You didn't even -- you  
21 had surveillance cameras.

22 VICE PRESIDENT FOREMAN: Mr. Russell, can you  
23 conclude, please.

24 MR. RUSSELL: I'm going to wrap it up. I'm



1 going to wrap it up.

2 I don't understand how it is that the  
3 State's Attorney, Kim Fox, she takes a job for the  
4 firm that sued the City, and now she rescues  
5 herself.

6 VICE PRESIDENT FOREMAN: Mr. Russell, thank  
7 you.

8 the next speaker is Pamela Hunt.

9 MS. HUNT: I'm going to start, as I do usually,  
10 and say that Rahm is a racist and Rahm needs to  
11 resign. And I'm not -- I've already stated why.  
12 Rahm is a racist and he needs to resigned.

13 And to you sitting in place of  
14 Superintendent Johnson, here is the problem. We  
15 now have a racist regime and control of the white  
16 House. You have a top cop, Sessions, who is a  
17 racist. And if you don't believe it, I recommend  
18 everybody read Coretta Scott King's letter stating  
19 what a racist pig he is.

20 So now here we are. We don't have a  
21 consent decree. So I wanted to ask Superintendent  
22 Johnson, because it was reported on Channel 9 that  
23 he went to Sessions and asked that they not pursue  
24 the consent decree. So I want to know is that



1 true? Because if that is indeed the case, then  
2 trust is out of the window.

3 Let me speak to the FOP and Dean Angelo.  
4 One of your problems, that poster right there,  
5 "Chicago Police Generations, a Proud Family." What  
6 if you're hiring a generation of racists? Has  
7 anybody even looked at that?

8 Dean Angelo has two family members on the  
9 police force. Channel 11, Dean Angelo's words,  
10 "The mistrust the black community has for the  
11 Police Department is caused by the elected  
12 officials who are promoting it." As if to discount  
13 the fact that we have been -- I've complained about  
14 the police, put in a complaint, other people had  
15 family members murder. Is Dean Angelo crazy? So  
16 now I don't know what leadership is now taking over  
17 the FOP.

18 Shawn Bridger, if he was a white man  
19 sitting in his car, asleep, you know what that  
20 would happen? "This is a wellness check. Are you  
21 okay, sir?" "Well, wake up, sir, so your baby will  
22 be safe." He doesn't get arrested. He doesn't go  
23 to jail. He doesn't die in jail of supposedly a  
24 cardiac arrest.



1           You know what, Eddy Johnson, be the  
2 change, he wants black people be on the force, be  
3 the change. what changes are you really going to  
4 bring? I asked you at the last meeting, what  
5 change are you all asking of the white community?  
6 what are you asking? It's their burden to end  
7 racism. These are their murdering brothers,  
8 sisters, fathers, aunts, and uncles.

9           Superintendent Johnson, he saw what  
10 happened in Mt. Greenwood. He saw the anger and  
11 the racism, and then you all flooded over there to  
12 shut it down and keep it quiet.

13           VICE PRESIDENT FOREMAN: Your time is up.  
14 Thank you.

15           MS. HUNT: well, I'm asking how much more do  
16 you all think black people are going to take? How  
17 much are black going to take? I want to tell Rahm  
18 Emanuel and Superintendent Johnson if they request  
19 that sessions stop the pursuit of that consent  
20 degree. Because all bets are off if you're talking  
21 about trust of the police.

22           VICE PRESIDENT FOREMAN: Mark Clements.

23           MR. CLEMENTS: Hello, and good evening. First  
24 of all, my name is Mark Clements, and I see Rita



1 here, I see Sharon.

2 Let me tell you, Kujaun Raye. This was a  
3 child. Do you know what his mama got for  
4 Thanksgiving? A dead son. Okay? Now, here it is,  
5 the City of Chicago did one of the largest hunts in  
6 history. As a matter of fact, it made history.  
7 They searched from 65th and Ashland all the way to  
8 the Dan Ryan for a gun. You didn't find it. You  
9 got two videos, it shows a young man running. No  
10 gun. This is a no brainer. You got to give us  
11 one.

12 And let me tell you about being a no  
13 brainer, here it is. I have been before you people  
14 I can say for the last six years, and let me tell  
15 you, you don't respond to our questions. What are  
16 you doing? Is this something just for a show? Is  
17 this just for a show? Here it is, right now today,  
18 the City of Chicago got one hundred Burge victims  
19 still in prison. The man confessed, tortures occur  
20 in police station.

21 Here it is, a Chicago Police Department  
22 that beats the heck of out of people, children,  
23 never called in the Illinois Department of Children  
24 and Family Services. Now we want to sit up here



1 and we want to try to make it look like we are  
2 standing for justice.

3 I think that Rita may know me a little  
4 bit more than all of you. I'm not afraid of anyone  
5 who wear a suit. Okay? You locked me up in prison  
6 for 28 years of my life. You let the killer stay  
7 out here in society. why should I not be mad? why  
8 in the hell should not I not be mad?

9 Now you have a different police  
10 detective, retired of course, with his whole  
11 goddamn full pension. And guess what? You got all  
12 of them victims over there at 26th and California,  
13 you're trying to play games. Because, guess what?  
14 The judge didn't die for a goddamn robbery. Let's  
15 tell it right. He died for a goddamn rob. Let's  
16 tell it right. See, so now you want to go and  
17 snatch this black man and lock his ass up in prison  
18 and the facts ain't there.

19 VICE PRESIDENT FOREMAN: Mr. Clements, your  
20 time is up.

21 MR. CLEMENTS: Tell the facts the way they need  
22 to be told.

23 VICE PRESIDENT FOREMAN: Please conclude.

24 MR. CLEMENTS: Mr. Foreman, this isn't right.



1 VICE PRESIDENT FOREMAN: Thank you.

2 The next speaker is a Crista Noel.

3 MS. NOEL: Good evening, everyone. I was  
4 looking at the definition for the serial killer.  
5 The Federal Bureau of Investigation says that the  
6 definition of a serial killer is the unlawful  
7 killing of two or more victims by the same offender  
8 in separate events.

9 So I have a question. How many serial  
10 killers are on the Chicago police force? How many  
11 Chicago police officers have killed two or more  
12 people in separate events? I know Rialmo killed  
13 two in one event. And I still, I just still have a  
14 problem with the fact that his 6 -- you know what I  
15 mean by his 6? 12, 3, 6, got your back, right?  
16 Tapped him on his shoulder and told him to watch  
17 out.

18 Now, you can't tap me on my shoulder if a  
19 bat is getting ready to hit me on my head and you  
20 got my 6. You have a gun out ready to shoot them  
21 right away because they getting ready to hit me in  
22 the head with a bat. So you can't tap me on my  
23 shoulder and say watch out.

24 So if you can tap me on my shoulder and



1 say "watch out," then I wasn't close enough to hurt  
2 you. Because you telling me, hey, look up and get  
3 out the way.

4 But Rialmo decided to shoot. Not his  
5 six, not his back up, Rialmo decided to shoot and  
6 he killed Bettie. And I don't care what you say,  
7 that was murder, because he should not have shot at  
8 all. Surgeon shouldn't have shot when Ratino  
9 (phonetic) was around or anyone else was around,  
10 Rialmo should not have shot when he saw a Bettie in  
11 that door.

12 And I totally disagree with the State's  
13 Attorney on not indicting him. He could have been  
14 indicted for involuntary manslaughter, I don't  
15 care. He could have been indicted for something.

16 Now, I got a problem with Michele Robey,  
17 too. Michele Robey was the woman that had the  
18 psychosocial disability that was running around the  
19 CVS about five, ten minutes with a knife  
20 threatening people and all the rest of the stuff.  
21 And everybody in that CVS did no have a weapon.  
22 And yet they were able to -- she was able to walk  
23 out of that CVS with no one harmed, and within  
24 three minutes of the police arriving with weapons,



1 she was shot and killed.

2 Now, I don't understand how I can run  
3 around a CVS with a knife threatening people, get  
4 out of there, no one's harmed, but when the police  
5 are involved, I'm killed.

6 Now, here is the real problem I have  
7 with Michele Robey. Michele was after Quintonio.  
8 And Quintonio, this was this whole big thing about  
9 how everything everybody is going to be trained on  
10 dealing with psychosocial disabilities, and right  
11 after Quintonio you go and shoot Michele. It  
12 doesn't make any sense.

13 It's like nothing works here. We hear a  
14 lot of talk and nobody does anything.

15 VICE PRESIDENT FOREMAN: Thank you. The next  
16 speaker is Queen Sister. Queen Sister.

17 The next speaker is EvAngel YHWHnewBN.

18 MS. YHWHnewBN: Greetings. Two things.  
19 Superintendent is absent again, so I can't address  
20 my questions to him so I'll address it to you.

21 He went to Springfield lobbying because  
22 he wanted stiffer sentences for gun violator  
23 repeats. Now, he has the jurisdiction over the  
24 police officers, but what is his plan, or what is



1 your plan, for repeat officer offenders such as  
2 Evans. I understand this Board recommended that he  
3 be fired. But after he went on trial for his DNA  
4 being found on the barrel of a suspect's -- that  
5 was found on the barrel of his gun, it made sense  
6 that he jammed it down his throat and that's how it  
7 got there. And he was recommended for firing.

8 But the Superintendent, who is  
9 campaigning all over America for stop these gun  
10 repeat offenders, but up in his nose, he's here  
11 protecting the officer repeat offenders. So I want  
12 to know what are you going to do about that?

13 You are all sitting on the Board, and  
14 what are you going to do about that? You need a  
15 plan to deal with that. Otherwise, there will be  
16 no trust, because that's a deal breaker.

17 So number two, every week when you have  
18 those little blue books, she sits over there and  
19 transcribes every word that somebody says. And  
20 then you put under certain names, like mine and  
21 others, "They spoke on various matters." "They  
22 spoke on different issues."

23 The point of the matter is you've got  
24 two minutes, you don't have time to speak on no



1 different issues. Do your jobs. Not that  
2 complicated. Write down what we are saying, or  
3 either write down the questions. Do your job.  
4 Don't just give us this book with this easy way,  
5 "I'm ignoring you and maybe you will go away." We  
6 are sick of that attitude.

7 And if you don't stop it, we will.

8 VICE PRESIDENT FOREMAN: Thank you. The next  
9 speaker is Robert More.

10 MR. MORE: It is the 20th of April of 2017.  
11 I'm Robert J. More, speaking on behalf of  
12 (inaudible) of the archangel, the executive  
13 committee, and the first question is what is the  
14 basis of the Superintendent's absence from the  
15 meeting today? Let the record reflect there is no  
16 answer to that question.

17 CHIEF WALLER: He's out the town.

18 MR. MORE: He's out of town again, okay. And  
19 he also missed the last meeting as I understand.  
20 The thing is is what I don't get into the records  
21 before I get cut off to quote the first four  
22 genesis.com, all lower case, eliminate spaces,  
23 ismacpdpolbdtg031617.html.

24 The purpose I can't now get into



1 (inaudible) to move on to operation, keep the  
2 Willis Tower standing. Here's the question. What  
3 could have been done in May of 2001 to ensure that,  
4 number one, the World Trade Center would never have  
5 been demolished; number two, if the World Trade  
6 Center was demolished and no first responder could  
7 have been legitimately sanctioned for refusing to  
8 enter the building based on the past track records,  
9 seeing what happened in Oklahoma City and other  
10 events; and number three, to secure the evidence of  
11 the cause of this atrocity in order that an  
12 adversarial adjudication of the cause whereof might  
13 have been accomplished.

14 This is a gigantic issue. It's my  
15 understanding there is no way, we're looking back  
16 15 years, this is a world-changing event what  
17 happened on September 11. And if we go into that,  
18 they have to control not the state of mind as I  
19 said at a prior meeting, I move to have that  
20 stricken from the record, but they had the  
21 control -- the global plantation owners had to  
22 control the presentation of the state of mind of at  
23 least ten or eleven different individuals,  
24 including the slave master in chief George Bush and



1 then Cheney, and then rest of them down the line,  
2 see head of CIA and FBI.

3 what I'm talking about is the New York  
4 City police superintendent Kerik. If they were not  
5 confident that they could control the presentation  
6 of the State of mind to a critical mass of the  
7 public, and that includes voters, consumers,  
8 potential posse members, grand jurors.

9 VICE PRESIDENT FOREMAN: Your time is up,


