CITY OF CHICAGO

Policy Regarding Training of Police Board Members and Hearing Officers¹

The following policy is created to ensure that Police Board members and hearing officers receive training that will enhance their knowledge and skills needed to perform their duties effectively.

- 1. Each Police Board member and hearing officer shall receive initial training in 2019, and shall receive annual training each calendar year thereafter.
- 2. Initial and annual training will cover, at a minimum, the following topics:

a. constitutional and other relevant law on police-community encounters, including law on the use of force and stops, searches, and arrests;

- b. police tactics;
- c. investigations of police conduct;
- d. impartial policing;
- e. policing individuals in crisis;
- f. CPD policies, procedures, and disciplinary rules;
- g. procedural justice; and

h. community outreach.

- 3. The Executive Director of the Police Board shall post on the Police Board website annually a report of the training provided and a list of the Police Board members and hearing officers that received training.
- 4. If a Police Board member does not receive initial training in 2019, or annual training in a particular calendar year, the Executive Director of the Police Board shall notify the Office of the Mayor.
- 5. If a Police Board hearing officer does not receive initial training in 2019, or annual training in a particular calendar year, the Police Board may suspend or terminate the hearing officer's service to the Board.
