Task Force Objectives

Transforming Chicago's unique waterway system into a **thriving and ecologically integrated natural asset**, capable of accommodating the needs of people, requires **coordinated planning**, investment and management

Aspire to, and realize no later than 2040, inland waterways in Chicago that are **inviting**, **productive and living**, that **support wildlife in-stream and on their banks**, and that **contribute to our city's resiliency**

- 1. Create principles for a system-wide and neighborhood focused approach to Chicago's waterways
 - a. Adoption of principles by government partners participating on Steering Committee
- 2. Review current policies and create recommendations to strengthen them

- 3. Inform near-term planning opportunities to advance collective priorities

- **Progress**: Broader themes and principles developed and finalized by the System Plans Working Group in November 2021.

- **Goal 2**: Review current policies and create recommendations to strengthen them
- **Progress**: Reviewed and provided recommendations on the following in 2022:
 - Sustainable Development Policy
 - Chicago River Design Guidelines related to opportunity sites along the South Branch of the Chicago River

Goal 3: Inform near-term planning opportunities to advance collective priorities:

- CDOT Access Study
- USACE PAS Restoration Framework Plan
- Industrial Corridor Modernization Process
- **Progress**: Task Force members participated in the following:
 - Workshops on the We Will Chicago citywide plan with recommendations provided
 - USACE PAS Workshops informing the location and description of Opportunity Sites for the Framework Plan
 - Focus Group participation for Southwest Industrial Corridor Study
 - Update on South Branch Parks Access Study

- **Goal 4**: Develop criteria to prioritize projects for identified funding opportunities
- **Progress**: USACE provided updates on potential next steps for funding projects identified as Opportunity Sites as part of the PAS Restoration Framework Plan

- **Goal 5**: Standardize process for reviewing riverfront development projects
- **Progress**: Created a standard process for reviewing development projects on the Chicago and Calumet rivers and providing feedback to developers. 11 projects were reviewed since 2021. There is also a Development Review Working Group page on the City's website, providing information about the group, developer presentations, and feedback letters.




