Drake Avenue, 601-03 N. Central Park Boulevard and 614 N. Spaulding Avenue in the Chicago/Central Park Tax Increment Financing Redevelopment Project Area, and 605 and 607 N. Sawyer Avenue, 524 and 530 N. Troy Avenue, and 3106, 3110, 3116, 3120, 3124 and 3145 W. Franklin Boulevard in the Kinzie Industrial Tax Increment Financing Redevelopment Project Area, to request alternative proposals and to approve the sale of the property to Nelson Mandela Apartments, LP if no responsive alternative proposals are received; and request authority for the Department of Planning and Development to negotiate a redevelopment agreement with Nelson Mandela Apartments, LP for redevelopment of the city property plus the developer property located at 600-02 N.
