



Federal Funding Accountability and Transparency Act (FFATA)

All Federal grants obligated on or after October 1, 2010 must meet the terms and conditions of the Federal Funding Accountability and Transparency Act of 2006 (FFATA) and the new requirements established by the federal Office of Management and Budget. As a prime recipient of federal funds, the **Department of Housing (DOH)** is required to collect sub-award and executive compensation information from sub-recipients for entry into a publicly searchable online database. Your agency, as a DOH delegate, is considered a federal sub-recipient and is therefore required to provide the sub-recipient information below for each federally-funded DOH contract you receive.
