




**Employment Growth  
(2010-2017 CAGR)**




**Industrial Jobs 2017  
(Job Count & Rank of 26)**




**Industrial Wage 2017  
(Average Wage & Rank of 26)**




**Wage Growth  
(2010-2017 CAGR)**




**Industrial Job CAGR 2010-2017  
(CAGR & Rank of 26)**




**Industrial Wage CAGR 2010-2017

**Employment Wage by Manufacturing Industry: Top 2**




