


**Employment Growth
(2010-2017 CAGR)**




**Industrial Jobs 2017
(Job Count & Rank of 26)**




**Industrial Wage 2017
(Average Wage & Rank of 26)**




**Wage Growth
(2010-2017 CAGR)**




**Industrial Job CAGR 2010-2017




Corridor Employment Totals by Year




Corridor Average Wage by Year


