Pursuant to 23 CFR 774.5(a), the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) hereby requests the Department of Housing and Urban Development's comments on the Draft Section 4(f) Evaluation – Mobility Improvements to Support the South Lakefront Framework Plan, City of Chicago, Cook County, Illinois, per 23 CFR 774.5(a). The proposed transportation improvements will require converting land from Jackson Park to a transportation use. Two properties near Jackson Park receive Section 8 rental assistance from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). One alternative that avoids impacts to Jackson Park would require complete or partial demolition of properties that receive Section 8 rental assistance from HUD. FHWA is coordinating with you to seek your comments on the draft Section 4(f) evaluation.

If comments are not received within 15-days after the comment deadline, the FHWA will assume a lack of objection and proceed with the action.
