PROHIBITION ON USING THE RIVERWALK AS AN INGRESS OR EGRESS POINT TO SWIM IN THE CHICAGO RIVER



BY AUTHORITY VESTED IN THE COMMISSIONER OF FLEET AND FACILITY MANAGEMENT PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 2-51-050 AND 10-36-145 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF CHICAGO, THE FOLLOWING RULE REGARDING THE RIVERWALK IS HEREBY ADOPTED.

PROHIBITION ON USING THE RIVERWALK AS AN INGRESS OR EGRESS POINT TO SWIM IN THE CHICAGO RIVER

No person shall use the Riverwalk as an ingress or egress point to swim in the Chicago River except as part of an event permitted by the City of Chicago that expressly allows for use of the Riverwalk as an ingress or egress point for swimming.

The rule adopted on 8/16/24 regarding Prohibition of Swimming at the Riverwalk is hereby rescinded and replaced by this rule.
