**PROHIBITION ON USING THE RIVERWALK AS AN INGRESS OR EGRESS
POINT TO SWIM IN THE CHICAGO RIVER**

No person shall use the Riverwalk as an ingress or egress point to swim in the Chicago River except as part of an event permitted by the City of Chicago that expressly allows for use of the Riverwalk as an ingress or egress point for swimming.

The rule adopted on 8/16/24 regarding Prohibition of Swimming at the Riverwalk is hereby rescinded and replaced by this rule.
