NOTICE OF CLARIFICATIONS

QUESTIONS FROM BIDDERS

The following questions and requests for clarification were submitted in accordance with the instructions provided in the Contract Documents. The City's response (shown in ***bold italics***) follows each question or request for clarification in the table below:

Question 1:	Page 91 of project specifications, Sheet S5-55 Certificate Regarding Debarment and Suspension, [potential bidder] is understanding that this form is to be filled out by the General Contractor and not by the lower tier subcontractors at the time of bid. If [potential bidder] is the successful low bidder on this project, then we would have to verify that the subcontractors used on the project are not debarred or disqualified from participating on this project. [Potential bidder] is planning on submitting this form just as a GC and not from our subcontractors at bid time, please verify that this is the intent from the City of Chicago.
Response:	<i>Correct, the form found on Sheet S5-55 is not required from subcontractors at bid time.</i>

In accordance with Section 1 of the "Requirements for Bidding and Instructions for Bidders" in Part One of Three: Interpretation of Contract Documents, the deadline for questions has passed. No additional questions will be answered prior to bid opening except as the Chief Procurement Officer, in her sole discretion, deems to be in the best interest of the City.
