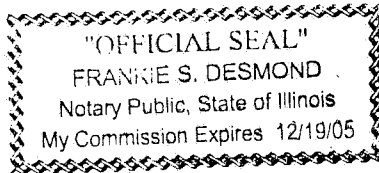

- Backfill to grade and provide safe temporary pavement.


Existing cables must be protected at all times during construction.


