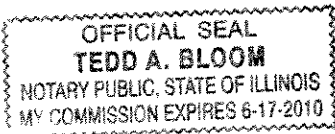

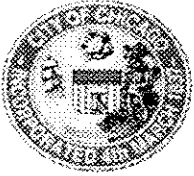

**1. Please describe the major features of this project.**

CDOT has to complete the 27th Ward menu program work this construction season. The work has to be done at various locations in the 27th Ward. The scope of work includes: sidewalk and alley reconstruction, ADA ramp installation and landscaping. The Residential Concrete Miscellaneous Asphalt (RCMA) contractors typically perform this work. However, due to the new ADA standards established by the City this year, the RCMA contractors do not have the time or manpower to complete the work this year. City Forces cannot perform these items because the City lacks the manpower.

The proposed work has to be completed by the end of this year's construction season. Therefore, it would not be time and cost effective for us to perform the work through The City's traditional bid process.
