

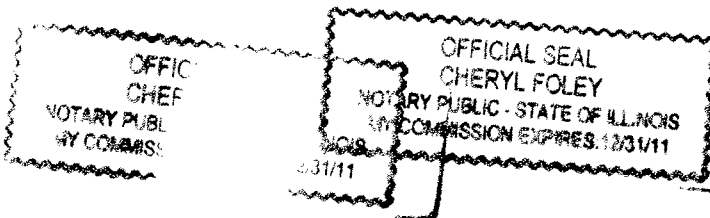

This project is removing embedded poles and restore affected areas on Clark from Chicago to Division. These poles need to be removed as of result of new residential lighting installed at this location.
