Role of An Assist Agency

- Promote the M/WBE program to its members and community
- Help explain to applicant firms the City of Chicago's certification process and assist with completion of certification documents
- Assist with dissemination of Department of Procurement Services information to Assist Agency members
- Attend quarterly City of Chicago workshops on procurement opportunities and processes

- Work with the City of Chicago and prime contractors to identify potential M/WBE subcontractors
- Provide feedback and information to the City of Chicago from its members and the community regarding the process or any topic to improve the City of Chicago's programs
- Participate in research projects conducted by the City of Chicago in order to document the amount of disparity and discrimination that affects M/WBE firms

How We Help: Funding

Access \$500 to \$5.5 million to fund your business.



Working Capital: Seasonal financing, export loans, revolving credit & refinanced business debt.



Fixed Assets: Furniture, real estate, machinery, equipment, construction & remodeling

How We Help: Funding Requirements

Small business owners work with lenders to get SBAguaranteed loans. The SBA does not directly loan money.



Be a for-profit business: The business is officially registered & operates legally.

Do business in the U.S.: The business is physically located & operates in the U.S. or its territories.

How We Help: Funding Requirements

The lender provides a full list of eligibility requirements for your loan.



Have invested equity: The business owner has invested their own time or money into the business.

Exhaust financing options:

The business cannot get funds from any other financial lender.

How We Help: Funding | Surety Bond Guarantees

Win construction, supply & service contracts with a guarantee the work will be completed

You can receive the bonding assistance necessary to compete for jobs via a **Surety Bond Guarantee**.



How it works:

- ✓ Surety bond is requested
- ✓ Surety partners with business
- ✓ SBA guarantees cost of contract up to \$6.5 million for prime/sub-contracts and up to \$10 million for federal
- ✓ Small business benefits
