




Program Overview

Annual Capital Funding Historic vs. Replacement Cycle







Local Area Map (Jackson Park Improvements)











Typical plan view of N. Milwaukee




Typical Section of N. Milwaukee



PROPOSED TYPICAL CROSS SECTION











Canal St. Corridor Viaduct Reconstruction: Madison Street to Adams Street

Scope: Replacement of viaduct on the east half of Canal Street as well as roadway rehabilitation, vaulted sidewalk reconstruction and utility upgrades.

MOT: The project will be staged construction maintaining local access and CTA movements.

Anticipated Bid: 2Q 2022 Construction Start: 3Q 2022 Construction End: 1Q 2024

Canal St. Corridor Viaduct Reconstruction: Adams Street to Jackson Boulevard

Scope: Replacement of viaduct/roof of Union Station that is the full width of Canal Street as well as superstructure rehabilitation.

MOT: Canal Street will be fully closed to vehicular traffic between Adams and Jackson but pedestrian access will be maintained.

Anticipated Bid: 2Q 2022 Construction Start: 3Q 2022 Construction End: 1Q 2024

Canal St. Corridor Viaduct Reconstruction: **Jackson Boulevard to Harrison Street**

Scope: Replacement of viaduct on the east half of Canal Street between Jackson and Van Buren as well as roadway rehabilitation, sidewalk reconstruction and utility upgrades between Jackson and Harrison.

MOT: The project will be staged construction maintaining local access and CTA movements.

Anticipated Bid: 2Q 2022 Construction Start: 3Q 2022 Construction End: 4Q 2023



Canal St. Corridor Viaduct Reconstruction: Harrison **Street to Taylor Street**

Scope: Replacement of viaduct that is the full width of Canal Street between Harrison and Taylor Street.

MOT: Canal Street will be fully closed to vehicular traffic but will be staged to allow access to adjacent properties.

The structure is a double-leaf, trunnion type bascule bridge. The structure is approximately 270 feet long with a roadway width of 36 feet and an out-to-out deck width of 60 feet. The bridge was originally constructed in 1914. Repairs Project.


