



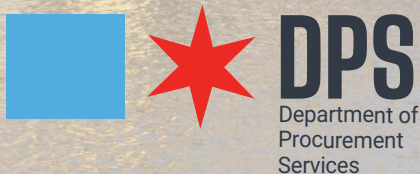

SMALL BUSINESS INITIATIVE | MID-SIZE BUSINESS INITIATIVE | TARGET MARKET



The City's key procurement priorities are creating opportunities for businesses of all sizes, and helping them grow so they can participate in the business of Chicago.

- **Small Business Initiative (SBI):** Exclusive to small businesses and limited to construction projects that are under \$3 million in total cost.
- **Mid-Sized Business Initiative (MBI):** Small and mid-sized local construction firms can bid on construction projects valued between \$3 and \$10 million. Expands the SBI construction programs.
- **Target Market Program:** Promotes contracting opportunities exclusively to businesses that are certified as minority or women-owned business enterprises.

CHICAGO WORKS: FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL PLAN

The Chicago Works Five-Year Capital Plan is a multi-billion-dollar initiative to allocate and improve the quality of life for all Chicago residents by investing in infrastructure and City facilities in all 77 communities. The Plan is estimated to put thousands of Chicagoans back to work and will address the decades-long backlog of infrastructure needs.

- Promotes equity, public safety and year-to-year project continuity by funding repairs in every neighborhood. Aims to reduce operational costs and years of complaints about aging infrastructure.
- Outlines significant steps to address deferred maintenance needs in City buildings such as libraries, firehouses, office buildings and health centers across Chicago.
- Contracting process will place a high priority on using minority, women-owned and locally owned businesses.

These meetings have grown into the Government Procurement Compliance (GPC) Forum, a strategic planning effort, which entails the formation a number of working subcommittees tasked with researching and reviewing best practices and recommending solutions to shared challenges.

Drive bold, cross-agency improvements to make our region the benchmark for procurement, certification, and compliance processes that are streamlined, standardized, equitable and transparent.

One of the objectives of the GPC for its participating agencies was to rollout this unified quarterly buying plan across the City, its sister agencies, as well as the County and State, so that vendors can better plan for bidding on government business.

The GPC Forum includes:
