SMALL BUSINESS INITIATIVE (SBI) & MID-SIZE BUSINESS INITIATIVE (MBI)

The City's key priorities in procurement are creating opportunities for businesses of all sizes, and helping businesses grow so that they can participate in the business of Chicago. The Small Business Initiative (SBI) is exclusive to small businesses and limited to construction projects that are under \$3 million in total cost. The Mid-Sized Business Initiative (MBI) is for small and mid-sized local construction firms to bid on construction projects valued between \$3 million and \$10 million. Expands the SBI I & II construction programs. The Target Market Program promotes contracting opportunities exclusively to businesses that are certified as minority or women-owned business enterprises..
