
Why






Working with Assist Agencies

Revolution Workshop is a 12 week, construction pre-apprenticeship training program.





Overview of Training



- 12 week training, every day 8 am 4 pm
- 70% of time in shop, 30% of in classroom
 - 1. Attendance/Punctuality
 - 2. Hustle
 - 3. Communication
 - 4. Attitude
 - 5. Hands-on skills
- Receive industry credentials: NCCER Core + OSHA 10
- Accountability (3 strikes your out)

Support Services



- Motivational coaching to address needs
- Classroom
 - Financial literacy
 - Job readiness
 - Construction career pathways
 - Life skills
- Additional supports: tools, PPE, transportation, food, union dues, alumni services

Contractor Involvement





- Employer Advisory Council (mix of ~12 union/nonunion contractors across trades)
- Job orders (honest skills assessments, zip codes, etc.)
- Feedback on new hires
- Support for new hires, if issues arise
- Hands-on demonstrations, job site tours, presentations
- On-site interviews, observations, tours, etc.

Next Steps





80% of trainees complete the program

90% of graduates receive construction jobs

Current cohort graduates in late March (~20 individuals)

Recruiting for new cohorts in Garfield Park and Pullman

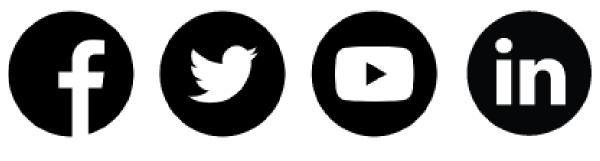
