SCOPE OF SERVICES

SCOPE

The Contractor must provide Data Coordination Services for the Early Childhood Locator, F.O.B., City of Chicago, Department of Children and Youth Services, in accordance with all terms and conditions of this specification.

The Maximum Compensation under this Agreement cannot exceed \$100,000.00.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Contractor will identify, coordinate and review data for the Early Childhood Locator. The Early Childhood Locator is an interactive mapping system and database that will offer the public quick access to information regarding program offerings and locations for the Department of Children and Youth Services and the Chicago Public Schools pre-school programs. The Contractor will not construct the Early Childhood Locator, or address software, hardware and maintenance requirements of the system.

ANALYSIS AND RESEARCH

The Contractor will estimate target population statistics and population changes through projection techniques and modeling methods for children ages 0 to 18 residing in Chicago. The unit of analysis will be jointly determined by the Department of Children and Youth Services and the Contractor. The unit of analysis will not be greater than a community area, or smaller than a census tract. This will be accomplished through a review of existing data, including those from the United States Census Bureau, the Department of Children and Youth Services, the Chicago Public Schools, the Chicago Department of Public Health and other city and state agencies.

The Contractor will advise the Department of Children and Youth Services on the design and distribution of data to reflect the number of children served by the Department of Children and Youth Services programs, their educational progress, and their academic and behavioral outcomes in later grades.

The Contractor will complete an assessment for the Department of Children and Youth Services on the availability of youth programs compared to the changing demographics and estimated demand in Chicago. As part of this analysis, the Contractor will map publicly funded youth and teen programs against general demographics and demand estimates for each community area. After comparing demand estimates with the identified supply, the Contractor will map the results in order to show levels of need throughout the city.

The Contractor will collect data on capacity and enrollment to allow a direct comparison between community area supply and demand. The results of this comparison will be used to rank the seventy-seven (77) community areas in terms of need for additional programs. After identifying the levels of need for youth and teen services based on the assessment, the Contractor will help the Department of Children and Youth Services make strategic decisions about resource allocation.

DELIVERABLES

The Contractor will provide a detailed report listing demographic information for each community area density maps, and an executive summary highlighting the results of the research. The Contractor will also provide quarterly reports for each unit of analysis that show the projected population for each year of service, trend analyses, and maps. At the conclusion of these reports, the Contractor will prepare a final report identifying the need for youth programs in each community area throughout the city.
