You recently asked our staff whether the City Ethics Ordinance contains any provisions which would prohibit you from accepting reimbursement from DEPARTMENT X [REDACTED] for expenses you incurred on your trip to LOCATION J [REDACTED] (February 2-5) to participate in a conference [REDACTED]

The Ethics Ordinance provisions pertaining to travel and hosting do not prohibit City departments from reimbursing their employees for expenses which are reasonably necessary for carrying out their official City duties and responsibilities.

The Ethics Ordinance provisions pertaining to travel primarily concern travel and hosting expenses provided by non-City sources. For your future reference, we have enclosed a summary of these Ordinance provisions.
