Per the email below and City's Ethics rules, I am sending this email to report on my recent trip to Vancouver, Canada which went from November 11 to November 14, 2019.

I participated in the City Leadership Forum on Urban Mobility, hosted by the Cities Today Institute. I participated in this forum in my official capacity as Acting Commissioner of the Chicago Department of Transportation.

The Cities Today Institute paid for airfare to Vancouver, two nights hotel, transport from hotel to the airport, as well as 2 breakfasts, 2 lunches and one dinner.
