Hi Steve and Reshma - looping Lisa in as I know Steve is out of the office. As shared with Steve and Lisa, the press release about the GAR restoration will be out tomorrow so I wanted to circle back on DCASE's acceptance of the in-kind grant of services. In terms of documentation, as recommended by Steve below, DCASE is accepting this in-kind grant of services and is in a contractual agreement (ROI) with the project manager, authorized by DCASE's 2020 Ordinance, Section 27, and Municipal Code 2-28-030(m), approved by Commissioner Mark Kelly. The donor is known by DCASE, and limited City staff involved in the project, but they wish to remain publicly anonymous.

Please note, the work is still underway and will be completed February 2022. I'm sharing this with you now, however, the value of the grant may change if the project comes in over/under the \$14,675,000 budget. Should there be a change in the total value of the project, once completed, I will let you know.
