

## Volunteer for the Chicago Point-in-Time Homeless Count 8 PM - 2 AM Thursday, January 25th, 2018 – Citywide

- <u>What?</u> The Point-In-Time Homeless Count provides the Department of Family & Support Services (DFSS) with a "snapshot" of Chicago's homeless population. All persons in shelter are counted and a sample is interviewed. On the street, teams will search public spaces and streets, parks, viaducts, CTA lines, and more. Homeless persons are tallied or interviewed if possible.
- <u>Why?</u> The data gathered on the homeless in Chicago is required for Federal funding, for service and resource planning, and to raise public awareness about homelessness.
- <u>Who?</u> Anyone 18 or older can register and select one of many locations to meet that night. No experience necessary. You will be assigned to a team of 3 or 4 people with at least one person having experience. The Chicago Police Department, Department of Aviation, Park District, and CTA assist to complete the canvas.
- <u>When?</u> Arrive at 8PM to receive training. Teams are dispatched around 10PM and will ride along in a team members' vehicle. The team will canvas the streets and public spaces. A team may need until 2AM to cover the assigned area and conduct the 20 minute surveys.
- How? Teams receive tally forms and surveys along with a map of a specific area in the City. DFSS also provides hats, gloves, and socks to distribute. You will be in and out of the car as you canvas 24-hour establishments and other public spaces. Dress warmly. A survey takes about 15 minutes to complete. All teams must return to the meeting site to submit all the forms.
