**STATEMENT FROM MAYOR RAHM EMANUEL ON KRAFT HEINZ LOCATING IN  
CHICAGO**

"Kraft Heinz has made a long term commitment to the City of Chicago, bringing new jobs and more economic opportunities to the city with its decision to relocate its co-headquarter location here. Kraft started in Chicago and I could not be more pleased that the company is returning to its roots – recognizing the talent we have, the growing and vibrant business community that we have, and the opportunities that exist in Chicago to connect with more customers and companies.
