

Mobility Disabilities Communication Access Tips

• **Do not** use term "wheelchair-bound"

- No one is bound to their wheelchair. People transfer in/out of their chairs all the time. They do not sleep in their wheelchairs.
- **Hands off!** Mobility devices like wheelchairs and scooters are considered an extension of the person, so do not touch or lean on their chair, as it is part of their personal space.
- If conversation is for extended period of time, make the effort to be eye-level
 - Use a chair so you are eye level, if possible.
- Take time to be familiar with accessible restrooms and routes at your facility, so you can direct people to accessible restrooms and routes.
- Accessibility: Accessible physical spaces ramps, elevators, lifts, accessible seating (take time to ensure accessible seating placement is inclusive), have meetings and events in accessible spaces, and if the space is not accessible, move to a space that is
