





The unit provides administrative oversight for all Department grant-funded programs, including researching funding opportunities, preparing grant proposals and budgets, and coordinating and expediting the grant application and award processes.

R & D collects, analyzes and maintains key statistical data concerning incidents, arrests, batteries, assaults against Department members and other criminal-justice data necessary to meet state and federal reporting requirements.
