Alderman Waguespack and Alderman Beale requested the revenue loss associated with pausing water shut-offs by type of household and Ward.

The attached report shows revenue collected (2017 - 2020) within 30 days following a closed Shut Off for non-payment work order. It does not show overall collection numbers. The furthest right column shows the percentage of revenue collected following Shut Off orders worked.

Alderman Vasquez requested the amount of funds spent on street sweepers, including labor and vehicles, and the projected spend going forward.

The Department of Water Management has spent \$5,278,500 for the maintenance, repairs, and fuel for street sweepers. This cost has remained the same over the past three years. In addition, The Department of Water Management has spent \$7,300,000 for personnel cost for city street sweepers. This cost also has remained the same over the three years.

The Department of Streets and Sanitation administers street sweeping services for the Department of Water Management to help clean and maintain our sewer infrastructure. The Department of Water Management maintains over 4,400 miles of sewer mains, 200,000 catch basins and 145,000 manholes. The street sweeping services provided by DSS is an essential function that keeps the catch basins, manholes and main sewers clean of debris. The cleaning of debris off the streets keeps the debris from entering our infrastructure and reduces the number of cleanings DWM must perform and reduces potential flooding for our customers.

Restoration work for these projects is completed under various, different contracts, either on water / sewer contracts or under restoration term agreement contracts. In general, the language for the work under the restoration term contracts reads:

"Scope of Work: The Work includes the restoration of streets and parkways including all required excavation, trenching, grading, backfilling and compaction of excavations, construction of ADA sidewalk ramps, restoration of pavements, curbs, walkways, landscaped areas; maintenance of traffic; and removal of all construction debris as described in the detail specifications, including all appurtenant work and accessories, all in accordance with the Contract Documents for restoration after construction, of water mains and sewer mains by Department forces."

Ward complaints or inquiries typically involve clarification of work and timeline. DWM does not log the complaints related to restoration by ward and these are not tracked.

With reference to Commissioner's authority for restoration upgrades, the contracts mentioned above have different line items and requirements for restoration items and Commissioner's authority is laid out in these contracts as they relate to different items of work.

Alderman Martin asked whether DWM has conducted any CIPP demos/pilots with a private drain in the last two years. If so, when, where, and what were the results? If not, why not?

A pilot project for rehabilitating private drains was started late 2019. The locations are in Wards 19, 27 and 48. The work related to the pilot and the water mains is ongoing, and the findings will be finalized once the work is completed.
