The following information is provided in response to questions posed at our department's hearing on October 24, 2022, to discuss the proposed 2023 budget.

Chairwoman Dowell requested more information on the salary disparity among ethnically diverse senior management, as the Equity Dashboard reflects 67% of Law senior managers are white, and they on average are paid more than ethnically diverse senior managers.

While the top 2 earners in the Department (Celia Meza, Corporation Counsel, scheduled to make \$195K in 2023, and Cicely Porter, Chief Labor Negotiator, scheduled to make \$175K in 2023) are women of color, the third highest paying job title in DOL is Deputy Corporation Counsel, and 89% of Deputy Corporation Counsels are White. For this reason, it is critically important to hire more diverse senior attorneys, particularly in Deputy Corporation Counsel roles, and if the requested salary increases are approved, this will increase recruitment marketability. DOL looks forward to partnering with interested City Council members on sharing attorney job posts with their networks. Director of Attorney Recruitment and Professional Development, Shelley Sandoval, will follow up with City Council members.

The Law Department acknowledges the need to improve diversity among senior management on a whole, however DOL does want to note that excluding Deputy Corporation Counsels, 45% of other senior management titles are ethnically diverse, including the entire Labor Negotiator team, three Chief Assistant Corporation Counsels, and all the staff in senior Director roles for the Department. With the requested salary increases, the Labor Negotiator team and Chief Assistant Corporation Counsels will earn more in 2023.

Alderman Ervin asked how many times has the city surpassed \$2 million? For clarification excess insurance claims are submitted when payouts exceed \$20 million.

- O 2022: YTD, the City has received no insurance payments for excess-insurance claims. However, the City was recently granted summary judgment against one insurance carrier in the amount of \$3.75 million for a May 15, 2020, claim in Jacques Rivera, 12 C 4428, that was not paid by the carrier. The judgment is not yet final, and the carrier may appeal.
- 2021: The City received payments for excess-insurance claims on four cases for a total of \$15,809,819. See cases listed below. The City is also currently in dispute with a one carrier in Fields over an additional amount of approximately \$7 million related to plaintiff's attorney's fees that the City claims it is owed.

The following information is provided in response to requests submitted to Corporation Counsel, Celia Meza, in preparation of the Department of Law's Hearing on Monday, October 24, 2022.

1. Changes in headcount projected for 2023.

Response: 0.

2. Number of funded vacancies and breakdown for 2023.

Response: As of 9/26/22, there are 108 vacancies for 2023. See attached Vacancy Report.

3. Number of vacancies being cut – what positions (job titles) are being eliminated?

Response: 3. (These positions are being transferred to Department of Human Resources)

- 1696 Director of Labor Relations
- 1332 Assistant Director of Labor Relations
- 1386 Senior Labor Relations Specialist

4. Number of non-union employees to receive salary increases in 2023 budget.

Response: 204 non-union staff are proposed to receive salary increases due to request to increase salaries for attorney positions and Director of Finance.

5. Description of outsourced services projected for 2023.

Response:

The sole outsourced service is legal representation. Outside Counsel are used due to limited resources, and conflict of case representation. The spending for 2022 is projected at \$42M by year end and approximately the same for 2023, based on historical averages. The hourly rates have remained steady for several years so the only major increases or decreases would come from the case load that is sent to outside firms.

6. List of savings and cost-efficiencies due to zero-based budgeting.

Response:

The Department has approximately \$59,000 in overall non-personnel decreases for budget year 2023. DOL analyzed current spending trends to decrease spending in several accounts including Court Reporting line (0143) by \$10,500 and in the Stationary and Office Supplies (0350) the decrease was \$5,611. DOL had significant savings in reducing \$34,437 in the Lease/Purchase Equipment line (0159) by conducting an efficiency study and reducing/consolidating the number of Canon copiers and printers based on usage rates. DOL also eliminated an underutilized IT subscription from the IT Maintenance (0138) line that saved \$38,000.

7. Provide total number of Law Clerks in 2021 versus 2022 YTD and highlight staffing plans for the 2023 Budget.

Response:

In 2021, the Law Department employed 20 Law Clerks. Currently we employ 9 Law Clerks, however there were 11 additional Law Clerks who participated in the paid Summer 2022 Law Clerk Program. For BY2023, the Law Department has budgeted 22,770 hours for the BLE Division, 8,903 hours for the COAL Division and 23,510 hours for the LIP Division. Year-round Law Clerks work a minimum of 21 hours per week or a maximum of 35 hours per week at an hourly rate of \$15.40. For Summer 2023 Law Clerk Program, the Law Department has budgeted 5,250 hours to place Summer Law Clerks in their preferred DOL Division based on availability. Summer Law Clerks perform more advanced legal work and are selected through a highly competitive selection process. Summer Law Clerks work 35 hours per week at an hourly rate of \$17.00.
