In addition to the 2023/24 Chicago Works Program, the 2022-2026 Capital Improvement (CIP) includes \$34.7 million for library upgrades, ADA improvements, and a new library branch.

Alderman Vazquez asked for a report on libraries being distribution sites for cameras.

The City of Chicago has expanded the Home and Business Protection Program (HBPP) to remove financial barriers and ensure that more Chicago residents have access to private security devices.

Eligible Chicagoans will be able to apply for private security devices based on income and pick them up at designated community distribution sites, including select public library locations. However, this has not yet begun.
