

Emergency Rental Assistance Program-Awards



Since the 2021 ARO took effect to present (October 1, 2021 - October 19, 2023), a total of 53 ARO projects are constructed or under construction. These 53 projects will provide a total of 813 new affordable units, consisting of 180 studio units, 322 one-bedroom units, 201 two-bedroom units, 90 three-bedroom units, and 20 four-bedroom units.



- All 5 grantee finalists are amid site selection, due diligence, and closing processes.
- No locations are final until grant is awarded by DOH and grantee acquires property.
- The first closing is expected by EOY 2023, the rest to follow in 2024.

Building Neighborhoods and Affordable Homes (BNAH) Program Description

The BNAH Purchase Price Assistance Grant provides up to \$100,000 to qualifying buyers to assist in their purchase of primary, owner-occupied residences, that are located within the City of Chicago.

The BNAH Grant Funds are forgivable and are to be used for purchase assistance, to eligible homebuyers, at the time of their purchase of a newly constructed 1–4-unit residential property, in a city-wide area, built pursuant to a City of Chicago Land Sale Redevelopment Agreement.

To qualify, a home buyer must satisfy each of the following guidelines:

Eligible Property

A newly constructed single-family residential building containing no more than four (4) dwelling units, built pursuant to a City of Chicago Land Sale Redevelopment Agreement. If the residence is a 2–4-unit building, one unit of the residence must be the principal residence of the homebuyer.

<u>Income</u>

The annual gross income of the household cannot exceed 140% of the Area Median Income (AMI), per the Chicago Primary Metropolitan Statistical Area.

Principal Residence

The homebuyer must occupy the home as their principal residence for a minimum of a 10-year occupancy period. A principal residence is a home occupied primarily for residential purposes and does not include a home used as an investment property, as a recreational home or a home in which 15 percent or more of its total area is used for a trade or business.

Program Area

To be eligible for a BNAH grant, the home financed under the program must be located in the City of Chicago.
