This Substantial Amendment allocates CARES Act funding, projects, and priorities in response to COVID-19 from the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Entitlement Programs at the following amounts:

**Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) - \$46.7M**

**Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) - \$23.7M**

**Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) - \$1.5M**
