### NOTICE OF A VIRTUAL PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENT TO THE 2021 ACTION PLAN AND 2023 DRAFT ACTION PLAN

The City of Chicago's Office of Budget and Management, along with various HUD-Funded City Departments, will host a public hearing on the 2023 Draft Action Plan, which includes estimated funding in the amount of \$162,861,700 from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to provide resources to low-and-moderate income people and communities across the Chicago. This public hearing will also include a review the Substantial Amendment to the 2021 Action Plan, which includes new funds received under the American Rescue Plan (ARP) to support the Emergency Solutions Grant in the amount of \$663,000. This hearing will inform residents of eligible and priority funding categories and allow the public to provide input on the recommended uses of the funding received by HUD.

#### **The 2023 Action Plan in the amount of \$163,524,700, includes the following programs:**

- Community Development Block Grant (CDBG): **\$76,610,000**
  - Unobligated Carryover: **\$35,380,000**
  - Anticipated Program Income: **\$1,200,000**
- HOME Partnership Investment program (HOME): **\$21,442,700**
  - Anticipated Program Income: **\$11,219,000**
- Housing Opportunities for People with AIDS (HOPWA): **\$10,133,000**
- Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG): **\$6,877,000**
- Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG – ARP): **\$663,000**
