Community Development Block Grants (CDBG): \$74,498,058
HOME Investment Partnerships Grant (HOME): \$17,660,001.73
Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG): \$6,647,177
Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA): \$12,775,677

The **Consolidated Plan** is a five-year strategic plan that identifies Chicago's housing and community development needs, priorities, goals, and strategies.

The **Annual Action Plan** outlines how HUD funds will be used in a single year to meet the goals set forth in the Consolidated Plan.

The Plans guide how the City invests federal funds to support low- and moderate-income communities across Chicago.
