

CITY OF CHICAGO NOTICE OF PUBLIC COMMENT 2020-2024 CONSOLIDATED PLAN AND ACTION PLAN Substantial Amendment



The City of Chicago's Office of Budget and Management invites the public to review and comment on the Substantial Amendment for the 2020 Annual Action Plan and the 2020–2024 Consolidated Plan for the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Entitlement Programs:

Amended 2020 Annual Action Plan Allocation:

Community Development Block Grants (CDBG): \$79,493,093 HOME Investment Partnerships Grant (HOME): \$20,120,610

Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG): \$6,876,768

Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA): \$10,570,599 Community Development Block Grant CARES Act (CDBG-CV): \$66,860,727

The **Consolidated Plan** is a five-year strategic plan that identifies Chicago's housing and community development needs, priorities, goals, and strategies. The **Annual Action Plan** outlines how HUD funds will be used in a single year to meet the goals set forth in the Consolidated Plan. The Plans guide how the City invests federal funds to support low- and moderate-income communities across Chicago.

This **Amendment** redistributes unspent CDBG-CV funds to the Lead Service Line Replacement project. CDBG-CV funds were disbursed in 2020 and must be used by July 30, 2026.
