The City of Chicago's Office of Budget and Management invites the public to review and comment on the Substantial Amendment for the 2020 Annual Action Plan and the 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan for the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Entitlement Programs:

Amended 2020 Annual Action Plan Allocation:

Community Development Block Grants (CDBG): \$79,493,093

HOME Investment Partnerships Grant (HOME): \$20,120,610

Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG): \$6,876,768

Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA): \$10,570,599

Community Development Block Grant CARES Act (CDBG-CV): \$66,860,727

The **Consolidated Plan** is a five-year strategic plan that identifies Chicago's housing and community development needs, priorities, goals, and strategies. The **Annual Action Plan** outlines how HUD funds will be used in a single year to meet the goals set forth in the Consolidated Plan. The Plans guide how the City invests federal funds to support low- and moderate-income communities across Chicago.

This **Amendment** redistributes unspent CDBG-CV funds to the Lead Service Line Replacement project. CDBG-CV funds were disbursed in 2020 and must be used by July 30, 2026.
