# City of Chicago Office of Budget and Management Monthly Revenue Report

May 2025

This report offers a detailed "point-in-time" of the City's revenues as of May 2025, the fifth report of the fiscal year which extends from January through December 2025. It provides a glance at our revenue streams and sets the stage for our financial management throughout the year.

Some of the City's revenues experience a lag between the time the underlying economic activity occurred, and when the resulting revenue is collected. Further, seasonality in some revenue streams and the irregular nature of others may lead to significant variances from one month to the next.

#### **MONTHLY ANALYSIS**

Budgeted revenues through May total \$1,567 million or 28.9% of the fiscal year 2025 total. Actual revenue collections year-to-date are \$1,645 million, \$77.2 million or 4.9% above budget. Overall, positive variances in Utility Taxes, Transaction Taxes, Income Tax, and Internal Service Earnings are being offset by negative variances in Charges for Services and Personal Property Replacement Taxes (PPRT).

Utility Taxes include taxes such as natural gas, electric, telecommunications, and cable. For this category, natural gas pricing and usage has led to revenues exceeding budgeted expectations. Income Tax also exceeded expectations through higher capital gains and interest earnings during tax year 2024.

Transaction Taxes include Personal Property Lease Transaction (PPLT), Motor Vehicle Lessor, and Real Property Transfer Taxes (RPTT). PPLT revenue, which is a tax on leasing personal property such as equipment, automobiles, and cloud-based storage, serves as the primary driver of the positive variances in this category as industry growth and product demand has continued to exceed expectations.

While Internal Service Earnings reimbursements are running ahead of schedule, Charges for Service are below budget due to the City's Ground Emergency Medical Transportation (GEMT) program. GEMT is a federally funded Medicaid program that allows cities an opportunity to collect an additional Medicaid reimbursement for ambulance services, above and beyond what the State reimburses for Medicaid claims for Emergency Transportation.

Per the Illinois Department of Revenue, PPRT are revenues collected by the state of Illinois from corporations, partnerships, and trusts that are then paid to local governments to replace money that was lost by local governments when their powers to impose personal property taxes on these business entities were removed. State estimates for PPRT revenue allocations are down nearly \$1 billion from last year as the state diverts, transfers, and trues-up tax revenues from PPRT.

OBM will continue to monitor revenue performance to determine if any adjustments within the fiscal year budget are necessary.
