

## City of Chicago Office of Budget and Management Comparative Estimate of Revenue Collections December 2023

As the city continues its post-pandemic recovery in 2023, some revenue streams are expected to chart a faster path to recovery, while others may lag based on economic conditions. Even during stable economic conditions, seasonality in some revenue streams and the irregular nature of others lead to significant variances from one month to the next that smooth out as the year progresses.

## MONTHLY ANALYSIS

This report presents a "snapshot" of the City's revenues as of December 2023. For multiple revenue sources, collections or remittances to the City may be one-to-three months later than the taxing period. Therefore, complete fiscal year 2023 revenue figures will continue to be finalized in the coming months.

Total collections through December are \$4.3 billion, \$201.6 million less or 4.5% under budget expectations. This variance is driven by collections from Internal Service Earnings (\$268.0 million), the Sales Tax Residual (\$72.1 million), and Transaction Taxes (\$47.7 million). Variance in collections for internal service earnings are timing related as the City awaits reimbursement payments. The lower-than-budgeted revenue from the Sales Tax Residual is due to less residual revenue coming to the Corporate Fund as more sales tax proceeds go towards debt service from a recent debt restructuring. The variance in Transaction Taxes is driven by the Real Property Transfer Tax, which has been impacted by a slowdown in real estate activity throughout 2023.

At the same time, favorable collections from the Personal Property Replacement Tax (\$145.8 million), Transportation Taxes (\$35.4 million), Recreation Taxes (\$23.5 million), and Business Taxes (\$20.7 million) have had an offsetting or mitigating effect. A revised allocation formula for Personal Property Replacement Tax resulted in increased disbursements from the State. A healthy return to pre-pandemic leisure activity, large entertainment events, and increased tourism have led to higher revenues for Transportation Taxes, Recreation Taxes, and Business Taxes.
