City of Chicago Office of Budget and Management Comparative Estimate of Revenue Collections March 2023

As the city continues its post-pandemic recovery in 2023, some revenue streams are expected to chart a faster path to recovery while others may lag based on economic conditions. Even during stable economic conditions, seasonality in some revenue streams and the irregular nature of others lead to significant variances from one month to the next that smooth out as the year progresses.

MONTHLY ANALYSIS

Total collections through March are \$4.5 million or 0.7% lower than budget expectations. Collections from internal service earnings (\$17.0 million), income taxes (\$8.9 million), transaction taxes (\$8.8 million), other revenue (\$3.0 million), and leases, rentals, and sales (\$1.3 million) are contributing to these variances. Internal service earnings variances through the year are timing related, while a slowdown in real estate activity is contributing to the underperformance in the real property transfer tax within the transaction taxes category for the third month in a row.

Offsetting these lower-than-expected collections are revenues from charges for services (\$22.3 million), fines, forfeitures, and penalties (\$5.7 million), transportation taxes (\$5.2 million), and business taxes (\$1.9 million).

It is important to note that the City does not collect revenue from a few major sources through the first quarter of the year, and that trends observed thus far are not sufficient to make adjustments to expectations for the full fiscal year. Some variances are likely timing related and should track closer to budget as the year progresses.
