The **CERT** program teaches members of the public basic, hands-on disaster response techniques and life-saving skills. CERT members train for a minimum of 27 hours in the following areas before becoming registered volunteers:

- Incident Preparedness • Fire Safety & Utility Controls • Light search and Rescue
- Team Organization • Disaster Psychology • Terrorism Response
- Disaster Medical Operations
