



Location Identifiers — Pole Markers

The Office of Emergency Management and Communications (OEMC) Location Identifier/Pole Marking Program was initiated through a combined effort of various City departments. “Pole Markers” serve as visual aids for the purposes of location identification by an individual and/or a first responder. It allows for an even more expeditious response by emergency personnel to incidents.



Location Identifiers

Letter and number combinations are used to identify locations. For instance, a sign listing the characters ‘M300’ would be located at approximately 300 E. Monroe St. and ‘LSD5132S’ would be at approximately 5132 S. DuSable Lake Shore Drive.

- Oak St. to Fullerton Ave.
- Montrose Dr. to Foster Dr.

Grant Park Area

- Columbus – Roosevelt to Randolph
- Balbo – Michigan to DuSable LSD
- Ida B. Wells – Michigan to Columbus
- Jackson – Michigan to DuSable LSD
- Monroe – Michigan to DuSable LSD
