Bureau of Rodent Control Introduction

- Bureau within the Department of Streets and Sanitation
 - Streets and Sanitation is the 3rd largest City of Chicago Department
- ▶ Bureau Headquarters: 2352 S Ashland Ave (312) 746-5230
- Crews provide services Citywide, all wards
- ► Also provide Rodent Control services to Chicago Park District
- Services
 - Rodent Control
 - Dead Animal Pick-up
 - Wasp/Hornet Removal

Bureau of Rodent Control Operations

- Operational responses driven by 311 requests
 - ► Call 311, or
 - ► 311.chicago.gov
- ► For efficiency, responses grouped geographically by wards
- Estimated response time is 5 days within 311 request
- Baiting locations
 - Public Right of Way
 - Alleys
 - Sewers
 - ▶ Back Yards only with owner consent
- No baiting for non-residential properties
- Only burrow baiting is performed
- Rodent abatement plan required for building demo permit



Bureau of Rodent Control Durkin Park

NOW

- As of this Tuesday (5/17), there were (11) 18th ward open service requests
- ► All requests will be resolved/closed out by this week
- ▶ Bureau performed walkthrough of Durkin Park on Thursday (5/19)
- Baiting will happen at Durkin Park and the sewers surrounding Durkin Park next week

Pre-Construction/Construction

- Bureau will inspect and bait Durkin Park, sewers surrounding Durkin Park, and blocks surrounding Durkin Park
- Bureau will coordinate with residents, construction team, representatives, 18th Ward Aldermanic Office to ensure appropriate rodent control response
