Dear Commission of Chicago Landmarks Members,

I am writing in support of the Morton Salt Adaptive Use project as referenced above. I understand that staff has recommended approval which includes landmarking and I am grateful to learn of this staff recommendation.

I am writing to specifically provide support and context pertaining to the Chicago Municipal Code section 2-120-620 Criteria 6 and 7 as it pertains to the Morton Salt "When it Rains it Pours" Roof sign.

I am sure that you have are already quite aware of National Parks Service Technical Preservation Services Preservation Brief #25 (the "Brief")¹. as it pertains to commercial signage. The Brief artfully provides examples from literature such as the lodging signage depicted in the novel Moby Dick by Ernest Hemingway or from The Spouter Inn by Peter Coffin. The Brief discusses how signage in our day-to-day lives, just like these literary references, provides a sense of identity to each place, and that old sign branding itself can also project a mood and symbolic messages. The Brief also reviews how roof signs tend to be simple often due to their large size and importantly the Brief recommends that they are ideally preserved in place.

The roof sign on the Morton Salt project is personal to me and my family. I want to share some of the history of how it came about as throngs of Chicagoans and visitors to Chicago observed the sign become an iconic symbol of Chicago's Industrial heritage.

The Morton Salt Company was formed in 1848. In 1914, the company branding and logo began to include the slogan "When it Rains it Pours" with a girl holding an umbrella in the rain. This slogan and logo referenced the anti-clumping properties of the product. The girl was updated in the 1920s and in 1941 her yellow dress was added.

In approximately 1952, my father Thomas J. O'Dea, became the Advertising Manager for Morton Salt. He was involved with all aspects of advertising, which, included the branding program across all business lines -- commercial, industrial and retail.

By the 1960's the world was undergoing significant social changes, and so it was again time to refresh the branding for the retail salt products. In the 1960's, the Morton Salt typography and girl in the yellow dress was updated. Her gaze was redirected, her hair style and yellow dress and shoes were updated, the slogan "When it rains it Pours" remained constant.

While the branding was being rolled out, Mr. O'Dea recognized the value and visibility of the large roof on the site under consideration today. He passed by the complex on his daily commute.

He arranged to have the sign installed, which reinforced the retail branding update. The signage over time for our family was always a reminder of our fathers ingenuity. At this point, the sign has become a beacon and a complement to the city of broad shoulders and a symbol of resilience. Over the years and as the City of Chicago moved more industrial complexes from the Goose Island area, the unique placement of this sign has also come to also represent the cultural and economic heritage of the city's industrial past.

I am excited for the adaptive reuse of the Morton Salt facility and Salt District. I believe that the venue will be richer for its reuse of so many of its industrial buildings. For me though, the most important part of this project will be the preservation of the roof sign.

I'm writing as a homeowner (2037 west North avenue) within the Milwaukee Avenue Historic District within concerns regarding the activity at 1460 N Milwaukee.

Put simply, the unauthorized demolition of the historic property follows a pattern all-too-common within the district. As a member of the Wicker Park Neighborhood Committee and as a neighbor, I've witnessed the same story numerous times in the neighborhood. Clearly renovations don't always go as planned, but with such drastic demolition carried out without authorization by the city, this property owner completely disregarded the strict regulations we all must adhere to within the District. From all appearances, the owner gained approval from the city for one thing, and then proceeded with something very different. Of course as a neighbor, I don't enjoy walking past the unsightly, partially demolished lot. But to simply allow the owner to proceed without suitable fines sets a very dangerous precedent. Certainly there would be owners across the city who would like to proceed with whatever building plan they want without authorization by the city. Particularly within the Historic District, owners should be required to operate within guidelines approved of by the city. To permit owners to behave as this owner has, we would quickly lose much of the value and character of the neighborhood we live in precisely because of the wonderful degree of preservation.

I am a member of the P&D Committee in Wicker Park as well as the Wicker Park Committee, and have been so for many years. I am also a resident of the 2100 block of W. Concord Place.

I developed the building at 1472 N. Milwaukee Ave., which received a Landmark Preservation award for the restoration of the building and the façade in 2005. I remember when the white ceramic tile/brick facade was removed by my contractor it was discovered that the original façade was still existing and partially intact. This particular building had extensive fire damage on the upper two floors and was basically a shell in that section. We never once considered trying to remove/demo the entire structure. We contacted Landmarks and consulted with them at the time to make sure we did a thorough and respectful restoration of the building.

I do not want to be redundant by repeating what Mr. Tamminga stated so thoroughly in his letter regarding the situation.

I just would like to say that I am dumbstruck as to why someone who intentionally tore down the building and then after-the-fact tried to claim that the façade was in unrepairable condition would be allowed to proceed by "rebuilding the original façade".

If they are allowed to proceed in this manner it sets a terrible precedent for what is supposed to be a protected Landmark district.

I am very much against allowing the owners to proceed in this manner.

It does not seem appropriate that a very mild reprimand is appropriate either. It comes across as an encouragement to others who might want to choose this path in the future in order to increase the square footage to the building simply for the purpose of financial gain with no respect for Landmark requirements in a protected district.

I am very much hoping for a better decision regarding this particular property.

I have reviewed the material for the February 4 virtual meeting of the Commission on Chicago Landmarks regarding agenda item 6 for the planned work project (permit application for demolition) on North Milwaukee Avenue. After review, naturally I recognize that a course of action was started by the owner demolishing the second and third floors of a previously declared contributing building to the Milwaukee Avenue District. This set of events has illustrated a potential circumvention historic property owners may wish to execute to compel a reworked or demolition solution more in their favor, at least as they may see it. This eliminates the effectiveness of local ordinances governing previously approved modifications to historic property.

I endorse an immediate review of this situation to identify controls that either did not exist or were violated that led to this outcome. Historic preservation ordinances are naturally ineffective with this set of events taking place.

I have to accept the premise that this could have been done purposefully, with intent, from Mr. Neikrug's involvement and participation. The fact the demolition of 2nd and 3rd floors of the historic building needed to be discovered adds to this possibility.

With that, I endorse the assessment of any fines or penalty against Mr. Neikrug or building ownership for violation of the scope of work communicated previously by both the Department of Buildings and Commission on Chicago Landmarks.

Our city's landmarked buildings are not just picture postcards. They are standing artifacts of our city's heritage. Every brick, every stone, every stick, every nail tell stories that we are not yet able to comprehend.

To preserve these stories for future generations is why we landmark buildings and when one is lost, its stories cannot be replaced by a postcard of what was once there.
