Landmarks Illinois is in full support of the Halsted-Willow Group district designation and hope the Department of Planning and Development agrees the designation would be in keeping with the goals of the department in the Lincoln Park community. Our organization has been working with Alderwoman Smith, Ranch Triangle and Lincoln Central Association since 2013 on this effort when several of the buildings initially became threatened and included the entire gateway on our annual Most Endangered Historic Places list in 2014. In October 2018, LI awarded a \$2000 Preservation Heritage Fund Grant to the Lincoln Central Association to help with funding to hire a consultant to prepare the landmark designation for the Halsted-Willow Group district.
