The Wicker Park Preservation & Development Committee reviewed and supported this project at its December 15 meeting. An official letter of support has been submitted to your Committee. At the P&D meeting a suggestion was made that, because of the excessive exposure of the west elevation, modular common brick rather than utility brick would be more consistent with the District architecture. The west elevation faces the alley and a parking lot across the alley, so it has full exposure to the roadway and the sidewalk. The architects response to the common brick suggestion was that it would be more money.

Personally, I would request that the PRC consider requiring common brick in lieu of utility brick.
