

# CDOT HOUSE MOVE CRITERIA

(as of 12/02/2013)

House Moving on the public way criteria is as follows:

- All utility disconnects are separate from CDOT/DIM, including water and sewer if applicable.
- The moving route including street closures must be approved and surveyed by the Chicago Police Department (CPD) and CDOT/Division of Infrastructure Management (DIM) & the Division of Engineering (DOE) for width and height clearance including railroad viaducts and CTA/Metra structures.
- The applicant must fill out the Oversize/Overweight truck application. The permit fee is \$150.00. Any CPD escort fees, if applicable, are over and above this permit fee.
- CDOT/DIM & DOE must approve the route if traveling on CDOT maintained bridges. IDOT must approve any crossings over IDOT bridges or highways.
- The applicant must furnish a certificate of Comprehensive General Liability and Auto Liability insurance including an endorsement that reads "*City of Chicago is an additional insured, as their interests may appear*". Minimum limits of liability \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence. The certificate holder must be the City of Chicago, Department of Transportation, Division of Infrastructure Management, Public Way Permit Office, City Hall - Room 905, 121 N. La Salle Street, Chicago, IL 60602.
- Any damage to the roadway, sidewalk, curb & gutter, and/or infrastructure is the responsibility of the House Moving permit holder.
- Hours of operation must be approved by CDOT/DIM, OEMC, and the Chicago Police Department (CPD).
- A detour plan must be submitted to and approved by the CDOT/DIM.
- All barricade placement and rental will be the responsibility of the permit holder.
- Escort and chase vehicles must be provided by the permit holder equipped with flashing lights; including support flagmen to assist.
- Contact the Department of Health and Economic Development Landmark Division and the Zoning Division and get written approval in regard to conforming with the department's rules and regulations.
